Steve Quinn has been an editor at In-Fisherman since 1988 and currently is Senior Editor of *In-Fisherman Magazine* as well as In-Fisherman's annual *Bass Guide*. He also is a Contributing Editor for other topical guides on Catfish, Walleye, Pike & Muskie, Panfish, Ice Fishing, and Gear. He writes features and columns, and works with field staff and free-lance writers and photographers to acquire and edit submissions. Steve's angling expertise also makes him a frequent co-host of In-Fisherman Television and a guest on In-Fisherman's national radio network. His fishing roots go back to the Adirondack Mountains, where as a youth, he and his brother pursued bullheads from pond banks.

A Certified Fisheries Scientist with the American Fisheries Society, Steve has also published scientific papers and book chapters on fish biology and management. Before joining In-Fisherman, he worked as a Fishery Biologist with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, where he conducted an extensive study of flathead catfish in the Flint River. He received a B. A. in English from Dickinson College and a M. S. in Fisheries Biology from the University of Massachusetts.
